SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Federal Infrastructure Bill provided funding to roughly 380 programs, of which 131 are new programs. The Port Infrastructure Development Program (PIDP) grants, from the United States Department of Transportation, Maritime Administration, is one of those existing programs. The next grant cycle will close May 2023.

One of the key limitations to business development at Port MacKenzie is that the Port has limited cargo handling equipment. The PIDP grant is one of the only port related grants that will allow for the purchase of equipment, and it requires the submittal of a benefit cost analysis, along with the grant application. Equipment such as a mobile harbor crane or travel lift would significantly improve cargo handling capabilities at Port

MacKenzie. When utilized with a roll-on/roll-off ramp, this capability would include the ability to dry dock vessels.

This task order will be funded, in an amount not to exceed \$41,419, from the Port Business Development and Marketing Plan project account in an attempt to secure additional Federal funding to support business development efforts.
