

January 31st: Assessment notices mailed, Values posted to the web, 30 day appeal period commences


March 1st: Appeal period ends


April 2nd: Appeal hearings begin


June 1st: Assessment roll certified










New Construction By Value

Additional Projects

- ▶ During the cyber incident staff processed 515 returned tax bills, approximately half of the address's on the returned bills were verified and corrected by speaking with property owners and through address verification and re-mailed.
- ▶ We began an estimated five year land modeling project, this involves doing a site inspection of each property and cataloging the land features. This will allow us to stratify the parcels into larger, similar groups and systematically update them.
- ▶ GIS helped us develop interactive electronic mapping for use with our IPad, eliminating the need for paper maps and providing beneficial information to appraisers in the field.
- ▶ We are currently working with property owners who have sustained damage to their property from the 2018 earthquake. We want to make sure we address any damage before the end of the appeal period.
- ▶ We have re-started our mobile project, this was halted during the cyber incident. We anticipate being mobile by spring of 2019.
