**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** The attached legislation will allocate \$451,860.00, consisting of \$316,302.00 in State Grant funding and \$135,558.00 in Borough match funding, to eleven non-profit organization for the provision of critically needed essential health and social services.

Twelve applications were received with one agency failing to provide a scope of work for how they intended to spend the grant funding, failing to provide a budget narrative and having two audit findings.
