## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-122

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$82,000 IN ADDITIONAL FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE, AND APPROVING THE AMENDED SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE MAT-SU BOROUGH FISH PASSAGE 2025 GRANT.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 22-220, and Resolution Serial No. 22-102.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby accepts and appropriates \$82,000 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) to fund 410, project no. 30114, Fish Passage Improvement for the Borough's Fish Passage 2025 project.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
