SUMMARY STATEMENT: In February of 2020, the Assembly authorized the Manager to execute an agreement with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to repair specific earthquake damage roads and bridges using Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds that required a 9.03% match. The Borough processed the 9.03% match from the 2018 November Cook Inlet Earthquake - Borough infrastructure/facilities repairs project, project 55027. A grant agreement from the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Public Assistance Grant Program (PAGP) received specifically for FHWA cost share of \$754,435.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: The Department of Public Works recommends accepting and appropriating the PAGP grant in the amount of \$754,435 to reimburse fund 445, 2018 Cook Inlet Earthquake-Borough infrastructure/facilities repairs project, project 55027.
