MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 22-045

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING MSB 2.12.030 TO CLARIFY THE DURATIONAL RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR ASSEMBLY DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance is found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 22-086.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. MSB 2.12.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.12.030 QUALIFICATIONS.

- (A) A person is eligible to be an Assembly member if the person is a qualified Borough voter and has been a Borough resident and a resident in the <u>territory</u> <u>embraced within the</u> assembly district for which they file for one year immediately prior to the election.
- (B) If an elected member ceases to reside within the district from which the member was elected, the member may serve only until the next regular election.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
