project will replace the existing culvert and broken fish ladder at the Crocker Creek and Settlers Bay Drive crossing, which impedes juvenile and adult fish movement. This crossing is a creek that flows directly into Cook Inlet, which provides important spawning and rearing habitat for several species of salmon and local fish species. ADF&G has designated this site as #20501156 on the anadromous waters catalog.

As part of the design process, utilities were requested to review the project design to determine if there are conflicts with their utilities. A purchase order (PO) was prepared for each utility for preliminary engineering with a reimbursable amount of up to \$5,000. If conflicts that cannot be worked around are identified, utility relocation is required before construction. Construction for this project is planned for the summer of 2024.

A cost estimate for reimbursable work (on a time and materials basis) was received from Matanuska Electric Association, Inc. (MEA) for the relocation of electric utilities in the amount of \$119,700. MSB 3.08.161 requires Assembly approval of any contract award over \$100,000.

The Administration requests approval for utility relocation costs of \$119,700 for MEA for Settlers Bay Drive at Crocker Creek Fish Passage Improvements. The new total of the MEA PO will be \$124,700 (\$5,000 + \$119,700). The completion date of the PO is 12/15/2024.

The Administration requests authority to extend this contract up to 185 days for unforeseen circumstances. The extended extension authority is requested due to the limited work that can be completed during winter.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approve utility relocation costs of \$119,700 to MEA for Settlers Bay Drive at Crocker Creek Fish Passage Improvements and approve authority to extend the time of performance up to 185 days.
