MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-073

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REAPPROPRIATING \$16,667 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 CAPITAL PROJECT BUDGET, FUND 480, TO FUND 440, PROJECT NO 20203, FOR THE REBARCHEK COLONY FARM CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreations, Office of History and Archaeology, has awarded a certified local government grant in the amount of \$25,000 to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alaska requires a 40 percent cash match equaling \$16,667 for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, in the fiscal year 2016 Capital Projects budget the Assembly appropriated \$190,000 in areawide funds for grant match; and

WHEREAS, it is our intention to use \$16,667 of these funds to meet the required match for this grant.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Reappropriation Source. The Assembly does hereby reappropriate grant match funds in the amount of \$16,667 from fund 480 to fund 440, project no, 20203.

Section 3. $\underline{\text{Effective Date}}$. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
