SUMMARY STATEMENT: Within the FY21 CIP budget, funds were approved for the Public Works Department, Solid Waste Division, to purchase a new Waste Container Hauling Truck. The Borough received a quote from Peterbilt motors to purchase a new Peterbilt 389 in the amount \$173,008.00 (that includes a 40.75% discount).

The new Peterbilt 389 will replace a 2004 Western Star (16 years old) truck that has over 156,000 miles. The new Peterbilt 389 will be used for the hauling of 120 cubic yard waste disposal containers. Once the replacement vehicle has been received, the old truck will be placed on the Public Surplus website for sale and disposal. The Central Landfill is located in Assembly District 2, however the truck will be used borough wide.

MSB 3.08.360 allows the Borough to enter into procurement agreements when it is in the best interest of the Borough. Sourcewell, formally known as the National Joint Powers Alliance

(NJPA), solicits, evaluates and awards contracts through a national competitive solicitation process on behalf of its members. Members can choose these contracts and procurement processes which satisfy borough solicitation requirements and avoid duplication of the process.

A cost proposal was requested, received and deemed acceptable from Peterbuilt Motors Company which represents Sourcewell. The quote received for the truck was \$173,008.00. The Solid Waste Division requests to use \$10,008.00 from Enterprise Fund Operating Budget account bringing the total amount available to \$173,008.00

Delivery is expected by October 31, 2020.
