SUMMARY STATEMENT: On January 17, 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) Purchasing Department issued a solicitation requesting proposals from qualified firms to design the Hidden Hills Road Reconstruction project. The Hidden Hills Road Reconstruction project, Project No. 35472-1800-1815, is part of the Transportation Infrastructure Program 2021 (TIP21), approved as Proposition 1 by MSB voters in November 2021. Per Proposition 1, the purpose of the Hidden Hills Road Reconstruction project is to reconstruct Hidden Hills Road to collector level road from the Parks Highway to S. Caswell Loop.

In response to the advertisement, four proposals were received. A proposal evaluation made up of MSB Public Works staff evaluated the proposals and selected Lounsbury & Associates, Inc. (Lounsbury) as the most qualified firm for this project.

The Purchasing Department, with the involvement of Public Works, negotiated with Lounsbury to develop a fee proposal for all professional services anticipated to complete the project. On March 15, 2022, Purchasing presented AM 22-017 for Assembly approval recommending the award of proposal No. 22-078P(A) to Lounsbury for the contract amount of \$369,919 to design improvements to Hidden Hills Road. The contract award was approved under the consent agenda.

Change Order No. 1 added \$94,951 to provide design services for fish passage improvements. During field investigations, it was discovered that culverts for an anadromous stream were failing and needed to be replaced. Change Order No. 1 was approved through AM No. 22-112 on September 6, 2022.

Change Order No. 2 added \$42,696 to modify the design drawings for phased construction and provide permitting and utility services. These services were required to advance the project to construction. The project was phased due to funding limitations. Change Order No. 2 was executed on March 17, 2023.

Change Order No. 3 added \$3,735 to develop exhibits and legal descriptions for two Public Use Easements (PUE) and a Temporary Construction Permit (TCE) required on the project. Change Order 3 was executed on April 14, 2023.

Change Order No. 4 added \$151,301 to provide construction management services for the improvements on the Hidden Hills Road Reconstruction Phase 1 and the Caswell Lakes Road Paving project. These services include pre-construction activities, construction administration/management, inspection, material sampling and testing, and construction closeout. This change order also extended the contract completion date to December 18, 2024. Change Order One No. 4 was approved through AM No. 23-035 on May 2, 2023.

Change Order No. 5 will add \$11,311 to update contract billing rates and extend the contract completion date to December 31, 2025, to match the existing construction contract and provide construction management services through the remainder of construction, contract closeout, and drafting of record drawings. Labor rates used for Change Order No. 4 were based on the original fee schedule developed in 2021, almost 4 years ago, with an initial contract completion date of October 31,2023. An update to these labor rates is requested to reflect current project costs and the new completion date. The additional \$11,311.00 is within the granting authority provided by AM 23-035 and will increase the contract total sum for all services and expenses to \$673,913.00.

Administration requests approval to extend completion date to December 31, 2025, for Contract No. 22-078P(A) with Lounsbury & Associates, Inc. for the Hidden Hills Road Reconstruction Phase 1 and the Caswell Lakes Road Paving project and to grant authority for an additional extension of the time of performance under this agreement for up to 220 days, in accordance with MSB 3.08.170. The 220 days is requested to accommodate stabilization if it is not achieved in 2025, and the contract will need to extend into the following growing season.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approve Change Order No. 5 to Contract No. 22-078P(A) with Lounsbury & Associates, Inc. for the Hidden Hills Road Reconstruction Phase 1 and the Caswell Lakes Road Paving project to extend the contract completion date to December 31, 2025, and grant authority to extend the time of performance by up to 220 days.
