SUMMARY STATEMENT: On May 9, 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to provide labor, materials, equipment, and supervision to make various improvements to the water system at Butte Elementary School. Work includes new water line from existing water well, separating domestic water from fire protection water, new exterior above ground fire water storage tank, new pressure tanks, and decommissioning an existing below ground interior water storage tank. Construction Services purchased will support the Public Works Department in assembly district #1.

In response to the advertisement, two bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Dirtworks, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on Total Bid Amount.

The substantial completion date for this project is January 6, 2023 with the final completion of January 16, 2023.

SCOPE OF WORK BID 22-139B

BIG LAKE AND BUTTE ES WATER SYSTEM REPLACEMENT

General Information

1. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough is requesting bids from qualified contractors to provide labor, materials, equipment, and supervision to make various improvements to the water systems at Big Lake and Butte Elementary School.

<u>Big Lake ES</u> work includes separating domestic water from fire protection water, new exterior above ground fire water storage tank, and decommissioning an existing below ground interior water storage tank.

<u>Butte ES</u> work includes a new water line from existing water well, separating domestic water from fire protection water, new exterior above ground fire water storage tank, new pressure tanks, and decommissioning an existing below ground interior water storage tank.

Pre-bids will be conducted on site and it is highly recommended that bidders attend.

2. To protect the morals, health, and safety of students, it is the policy of the MSB School District (MSBSD) to deny entrance onto the premises of any district school or any building used for school activities to registered sex offenders or persons required to register under the sex offender registration act of whom the district has knowledge.

The selected bidder shall take affirmative action to ensure that no contractor, employee, or subcontractor who will be working on MSBSD property has a criminal record of any conviction for child abuse or assault, be on the State of Alaska or any State Sexual Offender Registry, or has been convicted of a crime of moral turpitude. Any waiver of this section must be in writing, signed by the District's Superintendent. MSB has the right to verify such records at any time during the life of the contract.

- 3. The selected bidder shall comply with the MSBSD policy on Drug, Tobacco, and Alcohol-Free Workplace.
- **4.** Work Hours/Dates of Significance Work will be performed over school summer break, while school is out of session (see attached School Calendar). However, the contractor should make reasonable precautions to protect work as the schools may have community events and occasional summer staffing. In addition, the Facilities Department is staffed year-round and contractor will be required to coordinate work at each location so as to not impede normal operations.

Aug 10, 2022 - Teachers will report back to the school. After this date, work inside the school to be coordinated with the Project Manager and school principal. Work could be performed on the evenings and during the weekends and any school holidays. This building to have an operational sprinkler system and potable water supply at all times.
