A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE EAST NELSON ROAD PEDESTRIAN/BIKE PATH, PHASE II PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a donation in the amount of \$5,000 from Mr. Ryan Schlueter; and

WHEREAS, this donation came from the Gateway Community Council as part of the Community Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this donation is to fund the design and/or construction of an extension of the pedestrian/bike pathway along East Nelson Road; and

WHEREAS, the existing pedestrian/bike pathway extends from the Trunk Road Roundabout just south of the Parks Highway to Fetlock Road, then just south of the Wasilla Creek Bridge to Machetanz Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, this grant will help develop a project that would extend the pathway adjacent to Nelson Road from Machetanz Elementary School to South Withers Road; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds were accepted and appropriated by the Assembly with the adoption of Ordinance Serial No. 19-095; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the Assembly has approved a scope of work and budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Assembly hereby approves the following scope of work and budget for Project No. 35468.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

Continue the development of an extension of a pedestrian/bike pathway along E. Nelson Road from Machetanz Elementary School to South Withers Road, to be known as the E. Nelson Road Pedestrian/Bike Path, Phase II project.

**BUDGET**

Donation from Ryan Schlueter \$5,000
