A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING AND APPROVING TRANSIT SERVICE PROJECT PRIORITIES FOR TRANSIT PROVIDERS WITHIN THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, transit providers within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough have approached the borough requesting a resolution from the Assembly approving transit service project priorities; and

WHEREAS, a number of state and federal grants require a resolution from the local governing body approving the transit project priorities, in order for these agency to apply for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan 2018-2022, as adopted by the Assembly in November 2018, by Ordinance Serial No. 18-098, includes strategies to improve services; and


WHEREAS, improving affordability for recipients and improving information access and quality are two of the strategies identified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby supports and approves the following transit service project priorities:


1. Incremental cost of providing same day service or door-to-door service, aka discounted rides for seniors and persons with disabilities.

2. Travel training, travel trainers will teach seniors and persons with disabilities how to use Valley Transit system. It will go through scheduling demand response, reading fixed route schedules, fare structure, policies, and how to physically catch and ride the bus safely.


