#### SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough's (Borough) Transportation Infrastructure Program 2024 (TIP24) consists of ten projects that aim to reduce traffic congestion, support economic development, improve connectivity, enhance safety, increase reliability, and provide transportation choices for residents. Most of these projects are identified in the Borough's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), Official Streets and Highways Plan (OSHP), or Safe Routes to Schools Plan (SRTS); some were included in prior TIP approvals. Each project is programmed into five phases: Preliminary

Engineering, Design, Right-of-way, Utilities, and Construction.

On August 20, 2024, the Assembly adopted Ordinance Serial No. 24-070, authorizing areawide transportation projects and issuance of transportation bonds not to exceed \$36,390,000 contingent upon voters' approval in the November 5, 2024, election. The bond measure passed, and the election was officially certified on November 19, 2024.

With the passage of TIP24 and the related bond authorization, the Borough requests to enter into design, engineering, right-of-way acquisition, and construction contracts to begin the approved projects ahead of the actual bond issuance. All costs incurred prior to the bond issuance will be reimbursed to the Borough from the proceeds of the authorized bonds, with reimbursement expected in the March to April 2025 timeframe. This approach will allow the administration to accelerate project schedules and meet earlier construction timelines. The projects for which the administration requests front funding are:
