### SUMMARY STATEMENT:

## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH GREATER PALMER FIRE SERVICE AREA and CITY OF PALMER

### INTERGOVERNMENTAL FIRE SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS ADDENDUM NO. 3 hereby amends the June 2019 agreement between the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, a municipal corporation, hereafter referred to as "Borough" and the City of Palmer, a municipal corporation, hereafter referred to as "City" for the provision of fire protection services.

# SECTION 4. Compensation/Consideration

A. The Borough shall pay to the City an amount not to exceed 50% of Palmer Fire's annual operating budget between the Borough (GPFSA) and the City, as per Section 7.B of this Agreement. The amount for year four (2023) shall be \$555,906. The amount shall be paid in two equal payments each year. Compensation shall be reviewed annually and any request by the City of Palmer for an increase will occur before the Borough budget is approved for the next fiscal year. If the Borough Manager agrees to the requested amount, they will present it to the Assembly as appropriate with a request for appropriations for the next fiscal year.

Except as herein amended, all other terms,	conditions and requirements remain the same.
