## SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Department of Public Works is preparing an application for submittal to the Alaska Sustainable Salmon Fund by the deadline of June 12, 2024.

This project would continue a partnership between the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) to address fish passage barriers identified and prioritized by ADF&G, based on the

extent of upstream habitat and the severity of barriers to fish passage. This application will request \$932,000 for fish passage improvements to the culvert connecting Kings Lake with Anderson Lake, as well as the Anderson Lake outlet culvert at Charley Drive.

Alaska Sustainable Salmon Fund grants require a 35% match from local funds. Full match funding for this application is available from areawide budget appropriations designated for fish passage improvement match (Project No. 99999).

Additional legislation to accept and appropriate the funds will be presented to the Assembly once the grant has been awarded.
