A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE PALMER HIGH SCHOOL RENOVATION PROJECT NO. 40181.

WHEREAS, the Assembly approved the issuance and appropriation of the 2013 Series A, General Obligation School Bonds; and

WHEREAS, these bonds were issued for 12 projects, one of which was the Palmer High School Renovation and a second of which was the Valley Pathways School; and

WHEREAS, the Palmer High School Renovation needs additional funds to complete the project and to update antiquated mechanical systems to the school; and

WHEREAS, the Valley Pathways School project is complete with no open contracts and has a balance of \$1,732,505 in the account; and

WHEREAS, the Valley Pathways School project account is closed; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Department of Education and Early Childhood Development has approved reappropriation of \$1,732,505 from the Valley Pathways School project to the Palmer High School Renovation project as per 4 ACC 31.064; and

WHEREAS, the Bond Counsel concurs with the Alaska State Department of Education and Early Development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the following amended scope of work and budget for project no. 40181.
