Government Peak Overflow Parking Lot SCOPE OF WORK

General

This project's purpose is to install a new parking lot and pedestrian trail at the Government Peak Recreation Area. The project area is located off of N Mountain Trails Drive approximately 8.5 miles northwest of the Glenn Highway in the Palmer, Alaska. See project location and vicinity maps.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

Contractor is to provide resources to complete this project without any adjustments in the original bid amount or contract time.

Contractor is required to obtain an ADEC APDES permit prior to construction activities. Any utility relocation work done by utility companies will be performed under this permit.

Request locates from the utilities with facilities in the area. Use the Alaska Digline, Inc. Locate Call Center.

Contractor shall coordinate all improvements with all utility relocation work.

Work Zone speed limit: Limit speed of vehicles associated with the construction to 20 mph within project limits.

Normal work time will be between 7am and 7pm. Extensions will be considered an approved by MSB inspector.

Time is of the essence. Work shall be completed in one continuous timeframe. Substantial completion shall be achieved by September 30, 2023. Final completion shall be achieved by June 30, 2024.

Estimated project magnitude of the base bid is less than \$1,450,000.
