SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Matanuska-Susitna Borough (Borough) acquired land for right-of-way for the Port MacKenzie Rail Extension project. Several of the properties are large agricultural properties which the Borough expects to lease/rent during Fiscal Year 2025. Income generated from the lease/rental of these properties is considered project income. The Borough must plan and account for any anticipated project income annually.

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During Fiscal Year 2019, Staff anticipated the sale of one property (IM No. 19-004), but the property did not sell. Lease/rental income for the project during Fiscal Year 2019 totaled \$6,900.

During Fiscal Year 2020, Staff anticipated the sale of one property (IM 19-129), but the property did not sell. Lease/rental income for the project during Fiscal Year 2020 totaled \$21,900.

During Fiscal Year 2021, Staff anticipated the sale of one property (IM 20-145), but the property did not sell. Lease/rental income for the project during Fiscal Year 2021 totaled \$39,700.

During Fiscal Year 2022, Staff sold one property (IM 22-239) for \$601,819. In addition, lease/rental income for the project during Fiscal Year 2022 totaled \$33,850.

During Fiscal Year 2023, Staff did not sell any property. Lease/rental income for the project during Fiscal Year 2023 totaled \$33,273.

During Fiscal Year 2024, Staff did not sell any property. Lease/rental income for the project during Fiscal Year 2024 totaled \$33,487.50.

During Fiscal Year 2025, Staff does not anticipate the sale of any properties. Staff estimates lease/rental income of up to \$20,700. Staff will not collect any additional rental income from the residential buildings on Parcels 31 and 32 after the December 31, 2024, Rental Agreement expiration date. The income and income balances from the hay field permits on Parcels 31 and 32 will continue to be credited to the project after the grant expires.

This legislation will accept, appropriate, and outline a scope of work and budget for the anticipated income during Fiscal Year 2025. New legislation will be drafted and sent forward at the beginning of the next fiscal year for anticipated additional income.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approve this legislation.
