I MOVE to amend the Land & Resource Management Division Policy and Procedure Manual (page 25-14), Trail Dedication 7.4, to read as follows:

Trails shall be open to the public but may be <u>temporarily</u> restricted <u>for</u> to certain <u>purposes</u> uses, (e.g., equestrian, pedestrian, mountain bike, dog mushing, snow machines, etc.) (weight limits, closures for maintenance, maintain the <u>integrity of the trail, etc)</u>, if the restriction has been approved <u>and / or posted</u> by the borough. When it is determined a restricted use is required to maintain the integrity of the trail, a Manager's Decision document will be drafted for consideration and <u>temporary</u> approval by the Borough Manager. <u>Long-term restrictions to certain uses</u> (e.g., equestrian, pedestrian, mountain bike, dog mushing, snow machines, etc.) <u>may be</u> approved by the Assembly as recommended by the MSB Parks, Recreation and Trails Advisory Board.
