WHEREAS, Borough-owned land shall be classified in accordance

with Title 23 and such classification shall be used as a tool to

identify and guide future development of such land; and

WHEREAS, land classification cannot be changed without

Matanuska-Susitna Borough Planning Commission review and Assembly

approval; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution Serial

No. 25-05 recommending the Assembly approve the land

classification; and

WHEREAS, the Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area Board of

Supervisors passed a motion recommending to move forward with the

twelve and one half acre land classification.

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BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Approval. Assembly hereby approves the land classification of a twelve and one half acre portion of tax parcel 18N01E31C013, lying south of E. Bogard Road and N. Tait Drive intersection as Reserved Use Land for a future emergency services facility.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
