**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** In the 2024 Capital Projects Budget, an appropriation of \$94,242.93 was allocated to Project No. 15053-5300-5302, Fund 440, for the purpose of repairing the Wasilla Pool backwash pit and drains.

The project was completed under budget, resulting in a remaining balance of \$76,706.05.

Recreation facilities across the Mat-Su Borough were constructed at different times, and standards for ADA compliance and safety have evolved over the years. Additionally, some facility equipment has exceeded its useful life and is due for replacement. This

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legislation proposes to address several critical ADA and safety improvements at our recreation facilities, as outlined below:

• Palmer Pool: The existing ADA-compliant pool chair lift is no longer operational, and replacement parts are no longer available. Staff have identified a suitable replacement model, with an estimated cost of approximately \$20,000.

## • Big Lake Recreation Center:

- The front entrance requires installation of an ADA-compliant automatic door with access control to meet standards for width, maneuverability, and force of operation. The Borough IT Department has estimated the cost at \$27,000.
- The facility's locker rooms currently lack security doors, which are necessary to prevent theft, protect privacy, and ensure proper supervision. The estimated cost for this improvement is \$7,500.
- To enhance emergency egress at one of our highestoccupancy facilities, crash bars will be installed on the front entrance doors. The estimated cost for this upgrade is \$10,000.

**RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:** Respectfully request approval of the amended scope of work of project 15053-5300-5302, fund 440 to the Recreation Facilities ADA and Safety Upgrades.
