## SUMMARY STATEMENT:

During the Fiscal Year 2024 budget discussion, \$500,000 was included in the projected Areawide Fund Balance as a contingency for the 2024 Arctic Winter Games. As the games approach, the Host Society will likely experience a cash flow issue while awaiting the reimbursements from State grants and other donations.

The Mat-Su 2024 Arctic Winter Games Host Society has requested support from the Mat-Su Borough to alleviate cash flow concerns for February and March. Borough Administration is requesting the

full amount of the contingency fund be made available so we can respond quickly as needed. Funding will only be made available to the Host Society as needed and will be reported to the Assembly via Informational Memorandum.

The Host Society is currently showing a total fiscal gap of \$213,929. This is based on conservative estimates of merchandise, ticket, and post-game equipment sales. Additionally, the Host Society is working with Whitehorse to negotiate a price for the sale of beds being used for these games to the next community hosting the games. Additionally, the Host Society continues to work on sponsorships to close the remaining gap.

This legislation will place a \$500,000 contingency from Areawide Fund Balance into the project account as an "as needed" grant. The resolution will give the Borough Manager the authority to allocate the funding to the Arctic Winter Games Host Society.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approve this legislation.
