A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR ADDITIONAL DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS FOR THE 2018 NOVEMBER COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE.

WHEREAS, On November 30, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damages to Borough roads, schools, public facilities and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, a local, state and federal disaster declaration was issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25%) and federal (75%) funding assistance.

WHEREAS, the Borough was awarded \$293,322.29 for PW227 for repairs to fire stations throughout the Borough; and

WHEREAS, repair costs are higher than anticipated, and

WHEREAS, Amendment 5 was issued as a cost adjustment increasing the award amount by \$8,913.50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby amends the budget for a portion of the 2018 November Cook Inlet Earthquake Disaster, project no. 55027, fund 445.


