The Matanuska Susitna Borough is requesting a time extension for PW 206 and PW 137. This time extension request is based upon several factors to include:

- Due to construction timing constraints and completion of the project.
- A previous PD&E amended scope with no additional funding took 4 months to complete the
  process. By requesting additional funding the MSB has a legislation requirement to receive and
  allocated those funds which took two Assembly meetings, which required an additional 6-8
  weeks after FEMA and DHS&EM approval.
- For PW 206 all work has been completed since 10/30/2022, but final inspections were unable to completed until January 2023. Confusion on timelines caused this to occur.
- We are still in the process of close out, but active disaster responses by both the Mat-Su Borough
  and the State of Alaska have hampered our ability to close this project out in a timely manner.
- Please also include a time extension to extend the performance period to the end of January 2023 fo. PW 206 and the end of Decembe 2022 fo. PW 137.
- We would also like to request a close out liquidation period time extension for an additional 180 days.
