MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE COVID-19 DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS OF \$118,483.05 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND \$39,494.34 FROM THE STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, TO FUND 445, PROJECT NO. 55029.

WHEREAS, COVID-19 created an immediate threat to the health and safety of the general public requiring emergency response and protective measures; and

WHEREAS, a state and federal disaster declaration was issued on April 9, 2020, for the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25 percent) and federal (75 percent) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the first two awards for emergency protective measures from this disaster have been issued totaling \$157,977.39.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby authorize the

acceptance and appropriation of COVID-19 disaster relief monies to fund 445, in the amount of \$157,977.39, for project no. 55029, from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
