**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-016**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE COVID-19 DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS OF \$118,483.05 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND \$39,494.34 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, TO FUND 445, PROJECT NO. 55029.

WHEREAS, COVID-19 created an immediate threat to the health and safety of the general public requiring emergency response and protective measures; and

WHEREAS, a state and federal disaster declaration was issued on April 9, 2020, for the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25 percent) and federal (75 percent) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the first two awards for emergency protective measures from this disaster have been issued totaling \$157,977.39.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby authorize the

acceptance and appropriation of COVID-19 disaster relief monies to fund 445, in the amount of \$157,977.39, for project no. 55029, from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
