ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 18-069**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A REAPPROPRIATION OF \$36,000 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET 100-170-142, TO FUND 440, PROJECT NO. 15015, FOR ELECTRONIC PAYMENT KIOSKS AT THE JIM CREEK, WEST BUTTE, AND GOVERNMENT PEAK TRAILHEADS.

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly approved the charging of parking fees at the various Borough trailheads; and

WHEREAS, electronic payment kiosks will add a value of safety and additional options to those currently available to the public for paying the trailhead parking fees; and

WHEREAS, the funds for this project are available in the fiscal year 2018 Community Development Department Operating Budget which will lapse on June 30, 2018, if not reappropriated to a nonlapsing fund; and

WHEREAS, no funds can be spent until they have been reappropriated and the scope of work and amended budget has been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Reappropriation Source. There is hereby reappropriated by the Assembly \$36,000 from fund 100.170.142, to fund 440, project no. 15015, Trail Development

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
