AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$100,000 FROM GREATER BUTTE ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 26 FUND BALANCE, FUND 280, TO FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 30046, FOR GREATER BUTTE ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 26 ROAD MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to ensure all approved projects on the Road Service Area Maintenance and Improvements project list are fully funded; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to support as many future maintenance and repair capital projects as possible; and

WHEREAS, transferring funds to the capital projects will ensure all projects on the road service area maintenance and improvements project list have adequate funding and support additional future maintenance and repair capital projects; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 fund balance can be used to fund capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 Board of Supervisors and the Public Works Department would like to

transfer \$100,000 from Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 fund balance fund 280, to fund 410, project no. 30046, for the Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 maintenance and improvements capital projects.


BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.


Section 2. Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves the appropriation of \$100,000 from Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 fund balance, fund 280, to fund 410, project no. 30046, Greater Butte Road Service Area No. 26 maintenance and improvements capital projects.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
