EAST SMITH ROAD EXTENSION UPGRADE AND PATHWAY SCOPE OF WORK

General

The purpose of this project is to provide improved and safer residential and recreational trailhead access through reconstruction of the existing road and construction of a new separated pedestrian pathway.

The project will involve, but is not limited to, clearing and grubbing, removal of pavement, excavation, import and placement of borrow material, placing hot mix asphalt for the roadway and pathway, traffic markings, removal and replacement of guardrail, and placing topsoil and seed.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

- The project is located east of the Old Glenn Highway on East Smith Road Extension beginning at the intersection of North Smith Road and extending approximately 4600 feet to the eastern termination at North Kendy Circle and the McRoberts & Matanuska Peak trailhead. See project location and vicinity maps.
- A DOT&PF Approach Road Permit application has been submitted and preliminarily approved. The DOT&PF "Approval to Construct" is being processed and will be provided to the Contractor. The Contractor shall comply with the permit requirements and any special conditions identified by DOT&PF. The Contractor will be responsible to apply for and procure a lane closure permit from DOT&PF to perform the work within DOT&PF Right of Way. After construction is complete, the Contractor shall submit photos with an As-Built Survey or Record Drawings signed by a Civil Engineer licensed in the state of Alaska. The submittals must be reviewed and accepted by DOT&PF before the project can be closed out.
- Contractor is to provide resources to complete this project without any adjustments in the original bid amount or contract time.
- Contractor is required to obtain an ADEC APDES permit prior to work activities. Utility relocation
 work done by the utility companies will be performed under this permit.
- Contractor shall coordinate the road improvements with all utility relocation work. Request locates from the utilities having facilities in the area. Use the Alaska Digline, Inc. Locate Call Center. See Section 105-1.06 for Digline number and a list of utility companies in the area.
- Contractor shall complete ROW and utility easement staking and clearing and all necessary SWPPP items for utility relocation support upon NTP. This work shall be included in items 201(3B), 641(3), and 642(1). Additional stump removal for utility support will be directed if needed and is not included in these items.
