RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 26-036**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY DIRECTING THE MANAGER TO DETERMINE THE COSTS AND REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH SUBDIVIDING THE TANAINA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROPERTY INTO MULTIPLE LOTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF A LAND SALE TO THE YMCA OF ALASKA AND THE TANAINA COMMUNITY COUNCIL FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the YMCA of Alaska has expressed interest in acquiring Borough-owned land, for purpose of a multi-sport recreation facility; and

WHEREAS, Tanaina Community Council has expressed interest in acquiring Borough-owned land, for purpose of a public park; and

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale for this resolution are found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 26-056.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby directs staff to research, gather additional information and determine the costs associated with subdividing the Tanaina Elementary School property into multiple lots for the Assembly's future consideration of a land sale to the YMCA and Tanaina Community Council.
