RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 19-086**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ESTABLISHING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$50,000 FROM THE UNRESTRICTED NET ASSETS IN THE SOLID WASTE ENTERPRISE FUND, FUND 510, TO SOLID WASTE BUDGET LINE 510.150.416 426.900 FOR AN UPDATE TO THE LANDFILL DEVELOPMENT SEQUENCING PLAN AND GAS AND LEACHATE MANAGEMENT PLANS.

WHEREAS, the supplemental appropriation for this project were accepted and appropriated by Ordinance Serial No. 19-119 and the intent and rationale are contained in IM No. 19-163; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the Assembly has approved a scope of work and budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget for a supplemental appropriation of \$50,000 from the unrestricted net assets in the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund to the Solid Waste Budget for an update to the Landfill development sequencing plan and gas and leachate management plans.

SCOPE OF WORK

Develop an updated Landfill Development Plan, Landfill Gas Plan, and Leachate Management Plan wherein the Borough intends to evaluate various future landfill operations and capital projects including plans and costs associated with opening, operating and closing municipal solid waste and construction and demolition

debris cells, as well as a LFG capture system with associated infrastructure, as well as provide these plans as addendums to the fiscal year Alaska State Department of Environmental Conservation Landfill Operating Permit application.


