## SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Pre-Design & Engineering (PD&E) is consolidating and rescoping funds for right-of-way acquisitions that can be applied to areawide propositions such as Museum Drive Extension and Burma Road Upgrades and/or other TIP23 projects.

Funding is available in the Roads and Bridges Capital Projects, Fund 430, project 35040, Fiscal Year 2019 Seward Meridian Parkway Phase II. The final payment for local match has been made to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and the project is under construction. PD&E is requesting to rescope and amend the remaining funds in the amount of \$37,215. PD&E is also requesting to extend the expiration date to 6/30/2027.

The Miscellaneous Capital Projects, Fund 480, project 45177, has remaining funding in the amount of \$122,108.95 that PD&E would like to reappropriate and rescope for right-of-way acquisitions, and to extend the expiration date to 6/30/2027.

The approval of these request could significantly reduce the cost of parcels needed for road and highway ROW by allowing for purchase before the parcels become developed or further improved thereby saving the Matanuska-Susitna Borough tax-payers thousands of dollars. The funding will be used to purchase required right-of-way, in addition to title research, appraisals, acquisition services, platting and recording documents.
