WHEREAS, a prudent use of the \$120,000 in funding from the security project would be to reappropriate it to further support the apparatus purchase/replacement project; and

WHEREAS, the Central Mat-Su Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors supports this reappropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the amended budget for project no. 45066 to further

support the purchase/replacement of apparatus and associated equipment.
