SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Emergency Services Department requests authorization to reclassify an Administrative Assistant and a Mechanic I position to two, Mechanic II positions effective as of the date of this assembly meeting.

The Administrative Assistant position is currently vacant due to a resignation. The needs of another mechanic position currently outweigh the need to fill a full-time administrative position. The new Mechanic II position will be posted as a Mechanic I/II, and if a candidate is hired at a level one, they will be compensated as such until they meet the criteria of a Mechanic II, and then will be paid at the level of a Mechanic II.

The Mechanic I position is also currently vacant due to a

resignation, but in the process of being filled through the hiring process. In changing this to a Mechanic II position, the intended plan of progression will be that if a person is hired into the position as a Mechanic I and subsequently meets the criteria of the reclassified Mechanic II position, they will then be compensated at the higher level of a Mechanic II. Until such time as they meet the Mechanic II qualifications, they will remain being paid as a Mechanic I.

Reclassifying an Administrative Assistant to a Mechanic II position will result in an increased annual cost of \$18,394 if the position is filled with a qualified Mechanic II. The additional annual operational costs to reclassify a Mechanic I to a Mechanic II will be \$5,920 if the position is filled with a qualified Mechanic II. This totals an additional annual operational cost of \$24,314 if both positions are paid at Mechanic II levels for an entire year. The cost will be funded from the approved Fiscal Year 2023 operating budget.

This position reclassification will enable the Emergency Services Fleet Division to have the flexibility to hire either level one or level two mechanics with the Mechanic II position, and the ability to promote within the same job description when the employee meets the qualifications of the higher level Mechanic II.
