SUMMARY STATEMENT: In the fiscal year 2020 capital project budget, \$500,000 was appropriated for project no. 25048-2400-2414 for the fire suppression & ventilation repair/upgrades in order to comply with State of Alaska regulatory guidelines.

The engineers estimate to complete this project in fiscal year 2020, totaled \$613,800.00, exceeding the appropriated amount by \$113,800.00.

In the fiscal year 2020 capital project budget, \$70,000\$ was appropriated for project no. <math>25048-2400-2416 for the purchase of a Skid Steer. The skid steer was purchased with FY19 budget funds

and \$68,850.00 remains in the project fund.

In the fiscal year 2020 capital project budget, \$75,000 was appropriated for project no. 25048-2400-2417 for the purchase of replacement facilities for Universal Waste collection at Transfer Sites. This project is not moving forward in the near future and \$75,000.00 remains in the project fund.

Combining these Solid Waste Capital Project funds will provide the project no. 25048-2400-2414 with a total of \$643,850.00 to complete the project including a contingency.

The Solid Waste Division is requesting the budgets be amended for project no. 25048-2400-2416, fund 420, Skid Steer purchase, and project no. 25048-2400-2417, fund 420, Universal Waste Collection replacement facilities purchase, to project no. 25048-2400-2414, fund 420 to allow for the completion of the Fire Suppression & Ventilation Repair/Upgrades at the Hazardous Waste Facility / Administrative Office Building at the Central Landfill.
