SCOPE OF SERVICES

22-128P, EMERGENCY SERVICES MEDICAL DIRECTOR

This solicitation will result in a contract for the services of a medical director to perform the services as described in the following narrative. The contract is expected to begin July 1, 2022 and run for a period of five years with an option to renew for an additional years subject to Borough Assembly Approval.

- I. These functions must be performed by a single individual. If the request for proposal (RFP) is bid by a group, there must be a single individual within the group designated as the "Lead Medical Director" who will perform these functions:
- 1. Act as the designated Medical Director and Sponsoring Physician of record for the Matanuska Susitna Borough (MSB) Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Division ("MSB-EMS").
- 2. The Medical Director may select a Relief Medical Director, subject to Borough approval. The Relief Medical Director may temporarily act as Medical Director in the Medical Director's absence.
- 3. The Medical Director will act as the sponsoring physician of record for all MSB-EMS personnel authorized to perform medical care.
- 4. The Medical Director will work with MSB-EMS command staff to evaluate personnel regarding medical knowledge, patient care, documentation, communication, teamwork and leadership to optimize patient outcomes.
- 5. The Medical Director will be the physician of record for MSB-EMS sponsored certification classes.
- 6. The Medical Director will collaborate with MSB-EMS command staff to periodically design, revise, edit, condense and certify the Medical Standing Orders / Protocols under which MSB-EMS personnel practice.
 - 7. The Medical Director will ensure the availability of online medical control.
- 8. The Medical Director will assist MSB-EMS command staff with interpretation of data for quality assurance purposes.
- 9. The Medical Director will hold current valid DEA certificate(s) and a current valid license to practice medicine in Alaska.
- 10. The Medical Director will sign to authorize purchase of controlled substances, other medications and medical supplies requiring physician signature.
 - 11. The Medical Director may electronically sign documents where acceptable.
- 12. The Medical Director may make recommendations for the use of new devices, techniques or procedures, in conjunction with or separate from ongoing Standing Order/Protocol revision.

- 13. The Medical Director will collaborate with the MSB-EMS training department to design, deliver and evaluate training for MSB-EMS personnel.
- 14. The Medical Director will collaborate with the MSB-EMS quality assurance manager to facilitate optimal patient care.
- 15. The Medical Director will be the physician of record for the dispatch center, providing medical oversight of Priority Medical Dispatch and pre-arrival procedure instructions.
- 16. The Medical Director will maintain a close working relationship with Mat-Su Regional Medical Center's administration and Emergency Department physician staffing group to facilitate communication and to optimize patient care.
