SUMMARY STATEMENT: On December 17, 2020, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to realign, upgrade and improve the drainage along 3,843 linear feet of Bipond Cir., Hideaway Cir., Upper Ct., Glacier Dr., Iceberg Cir., Grantham Rd., Outlet View. This project involves, but is not limited to, clearing, grubbing, excavation, import and placement of borrow material, import and placement of aggregate base course, import and placement of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), installing drainage culverts and placing topsoil and seed. This project is located RSA #9 in the vicinity of Hyer Road. The streets that comprise this project may be

accessed from various points along Hyer Rd., which may be accessed by exiting the Parks Highway at MP 37.7. Construction Services purchased will support the Public Works Department in assembly districts #2 & #3.

In response to the advertisement, six bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Pruhs Construction Company, LLC as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on Total Bid Amount.

The substantial completion date for this project is October 15, 2021 with the final completion of November 30, 2021.

# CENTRAL MIDWAY STREETS IMPROVEMENTS SCOPE OF WORK

### **General**

This project's purpose is to realign, upgrade and improve the drainage along 3,843 linear feet of Bipond Cir., Hideaway Cir., Upper Ct., Glacier Dr., Iceberg Cir., Grantham Rd., Outlet View. This project will involve, but is not limited to, clearing, grubbing, excavation, import and placement of borrow material, import and placement of aggregate base course, import and placement of HMA, installing drainage culverts and placing topsoil and seed.

This project is located RSA #9 in the vicinity of Hyer Road. The streets that comprise this project may be accessed from various points along Hyer Rd., which may be accessed by exiting the Parks Highway at MP 37.7. See project location and vicinity maps.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the current Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

### **Work Description**

- Supply labor, equipment, materials and supplies to perform the required work as shown on the construction plans for MSB project number 18-09-1282.
- Contractor is to provide resources to complete this project without any adjustments in the original bid amount or contract time.
- Contractor shall coordinate the road improvements with all utility relocation work. Request locates from the utilities
  having facilities in the area. Use the Alaska Digline, Inc. Locate Call Center. See Section 105-1.06 for digline number
  and a list of utility companies in the area.
- Work Zone speed limit: Limit speed of vehicles associated with construction to 25 miles per hour within project limits.
- Normal work time will be between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Extensions will be considered and approved by the MSB Inspector.
- Contractor shall complete ROW and utility easement staking and clearing and all necessary SWPPP items for
  utility relocation support upon NTP. This work shall be included in items 201(3B), 642(1), 641(1), and 641(3).
  The additional utility clearing areas are as follows. All are 15' wide utility easements.
  - o 40+44 to 47+80 RT
  - o 60+00 to 64+50 RT
  - o 70+00 to 74+00 LT
  - o 75+00 to 86+25 RT
- Time is of the essence. Work shall be completed in one continuous timeframe after utility relocations are completed. Substantial completion shall be achieved by October 15, 2021 and final completion shall be achieved by November 30, 2021.
- Estimated project magnitude is less than \$500,000.
