SUMMARY STATEMENT: On April 21, 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to update the pavement markings on miscellaneous roads throughout the Matanuska Susitna Borough. Striping work will include various combinations of centerline, fog lines, turn lanes, stop bars, cross walks, speed humps, and painted medians in locations as described. Centerline striping is double solid stripe unless otherwise noted. Turn lanes include lane striping and all arrows and lettering required. Work includes labor, equipment, and materials to provide traffic control, layout, and striping. Construction Services purchased will support

the Public Works Department across all assembly districts.

In response to the advertisement, four bids were received. Award recommendation is being made to Specialized Pavement Marking, LLC as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder based on Total Bid Amount.

# 2022 ROAD STRIPING SCOPE OF WORK

#### General

This project's purpose is to update the pavement markings on miscellaneous roads throughout the Matanuska Susitna Borough. Striping work will include various combinations of centerline, fog lines, turn lanes, stop bars, cross walks, speed humps, and painted medians in locations as described. Centerline striping is double solid stripe unless otherwise noted. Turn lanes include lane striping and all arrows and lettering required. Work includes labor, equipment, and materials to provide traffic control, layout, and striping.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the current Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition and the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and the Alaska Traffic Manual Supplement (ATMS). Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

Work Zone speed limit: Limit speed of vehicles associated with construction to 20 miles per hour within project limits. At least one lane of traffic will be kept open at all times.

Normal work time will be between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Extensions will be considered by the MSB Superintendent if conditions warrant.

Striping work will be coordinated to follow summer 2022 Crack Sealing work in order to avoid covering new traffic paint with Crack Sealing. Striping work will be coordinated to follow Mat Su Borough street sweeping operations in order to get the best asphalt conditions possible for maintenance striping.

Time is of the essence. Substantial completion shall be achieved by August 31, 2022 and final completion shall be achieved by November 30, 2022.

Failure to comply with any requirements as described in this scope of work may be considered a material breach of the agreement, and is subject to termination as a result of non-compliance.

Estimated project magnitude is less than \$175,000

#### RSA 16

- N. 49<sup>th</sup> State Street approximately .5 mile of centerline and fog lines, turn lane 1 ea., stop bars 3 ea., cross walk

- Stringfield Road approximately 1.0 mile of centerline and fog lines, stop bar 1 ea. cross walk 1 ea.
- o Turner Road approximately .2 mile of centerline and fog lines, stop bars 2 ea.
- o Edgerton Parks Road approximately 3.0 miles of centerline and fog lines, stop bar 1 ea.
- Mountain Trails Drive approximately .8 mile of centerline and fog lines, stop bar 1 ea.

Work includes the Silver Creek Road Roundabout all painted markings associated with the roundabout and including travel lane striping and symbols from all four directions. 49<sup>th</sup> Street Roundabout all painted markings associated with the roundabout and including travel lane striping and symbols from all four directions. Other quantities in addition to the 2 ea. Roundabouts are Turn lanes with arrows 26 ea., Stop Bars 14 ea., Crosswalks 5 ea., Painted Medians 8 ea., Painted Bullnose (Medians) 16 ea., Bike Pathway with Bike Symbols 1.6 Mile, Center lines, shoulder striping, and lane striping to match existing for 4 Miles. This road section includes 2 ea. roundabouts and 3 ea. school zones and bidders are required to visit the work area and verify quantities prior to bidding. Where inlaid markings exist, the contractor shall apply markings over the top of existing markings, or within the groove if the marking doesn't exist, with the application rate (paint and beads) specified in Section 670 of this contract.

#### 1. Composition Requirements

a. <u>Pigment Composition:</u> Pigments shall be first quality grade pigments. The inert or filler pigments must be of a type and quality generally recognized as first quality paint grade products and shall not contribute to settling of the paint in storage or be so hard to cause excessive wear of the spray application equipment.

b. <u>Vehicle or Resinous Binder Composition</u>: The vehicle may be any combination of natural or synthetic resinous materials that are not prohibited per this specification. All resins used must be permanently capable of re-dissolving in the solvent combination used in the paint. Paint and binder combinations shall minimize build-up of the paint on the sides of tanks, paint lines and clogging of spray equipment from un-dissolvable skins.
