A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING
THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR PROJECT NO. 47525 TO ALLOW FOR COMMUNICATION
SITES INFRASTRUCTURE AND ENVIRONMENTAL MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADES.

WHEREAS, in the fiscal year 2020 Capital Projects budget, \$200,000 was appropriated to project no. 47525 to allow for the purchase of alternate communications towers and radios for Emergency Services stations; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services stations are in need of expanded telecommunications upgrades and maintenance beyond the current scope of work of this project; and

WHEREAS, we are requesting a revision in the scope of work to accommodate the upgrades, maintenance, and expansion that current infrastructure requires to bolster day-to-day and alternate communications capabilities; and

WHEREAS, these upgrades will ensure the longevity of all equipment installed in a communications shelter and provide adequate backup in case of system failures along with protecting against extreme environmental conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the following amended scope of work:

SCOPE OF WORK

Project No. 47525-1808 - Communication Sites Infrastructure and Environmental Maintenance and Upgrades; this will allow for the purchase of towers, antennas, environmental control systems, alarm systems, power systems and installations for all communications sites to include existing Fire/EMS stations.
