MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 25-049

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$932,200 FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME, SUSTAINABLE SALMON FUND FOR KINGS AND ANDERSON LAKES FISH PASSAGE IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 25-085 and Resolution Serial No. 25-037.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby accepts \$932,200 from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, Sustainable Salmon Fund, and appropriates \$413,100 to fund 410, project no. 30114, Kings Lake at Sierra Street Fish Passage Improvements, and \$519,100 to fund 410, project no. 30114, Anderson Lake at Charley Drive Fish Passage Improvements.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
