SCOPE OF WORK BID 25-144B

SUPPLY & INSTALL FENCING & ENTRANCE GATE AT THE CENTRAL LANDFILL

1) INTRODUCTION

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Solid Waste Division is requesting bids for a new chain link fence to be installed on the western and southern areas of the Landfill around the new entrance and entrance road.

2) BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Central Landfill (CFL) is located at the southern terminus of North 49th State Street off the Palmer Wasilla Highway, three miles from Palmer. The new fence and gates will serve to control public access to the CLF as required by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) 18 AAC 60.220 (1) control public access.

3) SCOPE OF WORK

Phase I New Gates and Fencing for road

- 1. New fencing will be installed starting at the existing fence post located on the southwest corner of the Animal Control parcel west to the toe of the road and then parallel the road and stop at the caul-de-sac at the entrance approximately 2,560 feet all within the Landfill shown on the map as per Attachment #1. The fence fabric shall be six (6) feet in height 9 gauge with three strands of barbed wire as per the Chain Link Fence and Gates Specification. Attachment #2.
- 2. There will be two (2) gates installed to access the CLF
- 3. Gate 1 shall be a 15-foot double swing, complete with latches and three (3) strands of barbwire.
- 4. Gate 2 shall be a 15-foot double swing, complete with latches and three (3) strands of barbwire.
- 5. This scope must be completed by 6/30/25.

Phase II New Gates and Fencing for Entrance

- 1. New fencing will be installed continuing from the caul-de-sac and extend around the perimeter of the entrance area to a post approximately 3,830 feet all within the Landfill shown on the map as per Attachment #3. The fence fabric shall be six (6) feet in height 9 gauge with three strands of barbed wire as per the Chain Link Fences and Gate Specifications. Attachment #2.
- 2. There will be two (2) gates installed to access the CLF.
- 3. Gate one (1) shall be a 15-foot double swing, complete with latches and three (3) strands of barbwire.
- 4. Gate two (2) shall be installed approximately 20 feet from the caul-de-sac, not to impede the entrance to the scale.
- 5. Gate two shall be a Structural Cantilever Slide Gate as manufactured by Tymetal Corp. or an approved equal. See Attachment #4.
- 6. An Automatic switch will be used to operate the gate; this will be used to operate the gate during operating hours, opening the gate at 8:00 AM and closing the gate at 5:00 PM. There will be an exit loop to open the gate upon departure from the landfill after hours
- 7. The gate will also come with 30 handheld openers.
- 8. This Scope must be Completed by 10/30/2025.

4) WORKDAYS AND HOURS

Perform work from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

5) CENTRAL LANDFILL RESPONSIBILITES

Provide staging area for materials pending installation.

6) CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITES

- 1. Provide work plan/Schedule and Safety Plan.
- 2. Be familiar with all job requirements, prior to submission of bid, changes or substitutions will not be accepted thereafter.
- 3. Ensure that work is done in strict compliance with all applicable legal and Matanuska Susitna Borough Code requirements.
- 4. Ensure that all applicable safety measures are enforced in connection with the work.
- 5. Ship, deliver, and unload equipment, fencing and gate system to the job site.
- 6. Install 6ft chain link fence 9 gauge with three strands of barbed wire and gates.

7) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Liquidated damages will begin on the day following June 30th for phase I and the following day after October 30th for phase II in the amount of \$250.00 per day until the work is completed.

8) PRE-BID MEETING

A Pre-Bid meeting will be conducted on site at the Central Landfill (conference room) on March 13th, 2025, at 10:00 AM.
