MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 25-042

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$448,174 FROM THE ENHANCED 911 FUND BALANCE TO A PROJECT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF PALMER TO OBTAIN REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE ENHANCED 911 SURCHARGE FUNDING FOR A VESTA 911 TELEPHONE SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Appropriation Source</u>. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves an appropriation of \$448,174 from the Enhanced 911 Fund Balance, fund 202, to project no. 45283, fund 480, to allow the City of Palmer to obtain reimbursement from Enhanced 911 surcharge funding for a VESTA 911 Telephone System.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
