SUMMARY STATEMENT: On February 10, 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Purchasing Division issued a solicitation requesting bids from qualified contractors to construct a new fish passage culvert at an existing culvert crossing on Hidden Hills Road at Caswell Creek, and reconstruct approximately 125 feet of Hidden Hills Road.

HIDDEN HILLS FISH PASSAGE SCOPE OF WORK

General

This project includes a new fish passage culvert at an existing culvert crossing on Hidden Hills Road at Caswell Creek. Also reconstruct Hidden Hills Road a distance of 125 feet. Grading, drainage, and other miscellaneous items of work shall be done as necessary.

All construction shall be completed in accordance with the current Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) 2017 Edition. Project specific special provisions are provided in the following sections. The requirements contained in these specifications and special provisions are hereby made a part of this solicitation and resultant contract.

Work Description

- Supply labor, supervision, equipment, materials and supplies to perform the required work as shown on construction documents for Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) project number 21-15-1279.
- Contractor is required to obtain and maintain an ADEC APDES permit.
- Contractor shall develop, implement and execute a Material Sampling and Testing Frequency plan and comply with the gravel mining permit requirements.
- The Contractor shall develop, implement and execute a Traffic Control Plan which maintains detour access around
 the project while a road closure is in place. Access for vehicles must be maintained at all times. Work Zone speed
 limit associated with construction shall be a maximum of 20 miles per hour within project limits.
- Normal work time will be between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Extensions may be considered and approved by the Borough's Representative.
- Time is of the essence. Work shall be performed in one continuous time period. Notice to Proceed is anticipated
 for April of 2022. Contractor shall complete the work no more than 30 Calendar Days after commencing
 operations. All in-water, below the ordinary water mark, shall be completed no later than the Substantial
 Completion date of September 30, 2022. All work shall be completed no later than the Final Completion date of
 July 31, 2023.
- Contractor shall follow and comply with all permit requirements. Permit applications have been submitted.
- Estimated project magnitude is less than \$300,000.
