**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** On November 30, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained damage to infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake. A borough, state and federal disaster declaration was issued for November 30, 2018. Allowed costs are eligible for 90% federal and 10% state funding assistance.

As a result of the earthquake, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe damage to borough roads, bridges, schools, public facilities and infrastructure. PW (Project Worksheet) 325 was awarded for the MSB Road Bridges project in the amount of \$143,148.00. Additional costs have been identified totaling \$447,459.00. FEMA and the state have issued Amendment No. 6 for

the amended scope of work increased costs as well as extending the project to December 31, 2025.
