## MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 20-095

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL DISASTER RELIEF FUNDS FOR THE 2018 COOK INLET EARTHQUAKE BOROUGH WIDE EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE MEASURES.

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018, the Borough sustained severe damages to roads, schools, public facilities, and infrastructure due to a magnitude 7.0 earthquake; and

WHEREAS, local, state, and federal disaster declarations were issued; and

WHEREAS, costs incurred during the disaster were determined to be eligible for state (25 percent) and federal (75 percent) funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough was awarded \$238,787.11 for Borough-Wide emergency protective measures; and

WHEREAS, an additional invoice for an infrastructure inspection was found and submitted for consideration; and

WHEREAS, Version 1 was issued as a final cost adjustment increasing the award amount by \$390.

## BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby approves the acceptance and appropriation of federal and state grant funds in the total amount of \$390 to fund 445, project no. 55027, for additional expenses caused from the 2018 earthquake disaster.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
