## SUMMARY STATEMENT:

In the Fiscal Year 2025 Capital Projects budget, \$855,000 was appropriated to project 45225-1844 to provide funding to replace the ambulance services fleet of Stryker Power Pro patient stretchers and Stair Pro wheelchair stretchers.

There are other companies offering comparable medical equipment and we would like the option of expanding beyond the Stryker brand to ensure we are purchasing the best options.

Additionally, the ambulance service utilizes of other types of durable medical equipment in the daily execution of their duties and responsibilities as Pre-Hospital Care Providers. These items
