Personnel, materials, supplies, and software costs; planning, training, and exercise for Points of Dispensing (POD); integration to support all aspects of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough's Emergency Operations Plan to include Points of Dispensing or Medical Counter Measures; personnel costs for coordinating the support of all EOP sections including but not limited to, memorandums of understanding and emergency preparedness and response. The original memorandum of agreement includes reimbursement of all costs incurred as of July 1, 2016, and the memorandum of agreement related to the additional funding includes reimbursement of all costs incurred as of March 1, 2017.
