SUMMARY STATEMENT: The intent of Ordinance 21-038 is to accept and appropriate cyber insurance proceeds from the Borough's property insurance carrier, XL America, for \$500,000. In addition, it is requested that \$947,893 be appropriated from Unassigned Areawide Fund Balance to Project 55025, 2018 Cyber Attack, to reimburse emergency expenses. All remediation vendors have been paid for services and all insurance proceeds have been received. Resolution 21-036 outlines the final scope of work and budget. Project expenses total \$2,447,893.

BACKGROUND:

On July 17, 2018, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough sustained severe and continuous losses to its Information System from a multipronged, multi-vectored advanced persistent malware Cyber Incident that began in May 2018. As a direct result the Borough's computer infrastructure, including computers/laptops, most Borough servers,

networked telephones and email exchange services needed repair and restoration.

On July 31, 2018 the Borough Manager declared a disaster emergency. A state level declaration of emergency was requested in an effort to gain access to public assistance and was subsequently denied. Assembly Resolution 18-062 extended the Borough declaration through October 16, 2018.

Assembly Ordinance 18-094, adopted December 18, 2018 reappropriated \$500,000 from the Major Repair and Renovation Reserve Fund 100, and \$500,000 from the Capital Expenditures Reserve Fund 100, to the Emergency Response Reserve Fund 100, for related project expenses. The total scope and budget for the project was not yet known.

Assembly Ordinance 19-014 was adopted on February 5, 2019, appropriating \$1,000,000 in insurance proceeds from AXIS Insurance. These were the full limits for the cyber insurance policy. At this time remediation was still ongoing and the full scope of work and budget was still unknown.

In April 2019 a subsequent \$500,000 claim was filed with the Borough's property insurance carrier, XL America. The claim settled in February 2021.

During the fiscal year 2021 budget process it was noted that the Emergency Reserve exceeded the amount allowed by code and the \$1,000,000 appropriated by Ordinance 18-094 was moved back into Unassigned Fund Balance.

RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION: Approve this legislation.
