**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

This resolution is at the request of Assembly Member Tew. The community has arranged for a community cleanup to target the areas near West Sunrise Drive and South Medora Cross Street to take place approximately from 09-02-2022 through 09-06-2022. After community members assessed the cleanup areas, it was discovered that junk cars and other large debris need to be removed.

The previously approved resolution had a specific scope of work and all of the appropriated money will not be used. The thirty junk cars near West Peaceful Place were dealt with in a unique way to be more efficient with the public's money. Traditionally, vehicles are

removed and brought to the Central Landfill. After they are at the landfill, a thirty-day legal process starts. After that time elapses, the vehicles are removed to a salvage yard; resulting in an additional tow.

With this current cleanup, the MSB initiated an in-place impound technique. Essentially, the MSB tagged the thirty vehicles and the legal process has started with vehicles in their current location at West Peaceful Place. After thirty days, the vehicles will be removed and taken to a salvage yard directly, eliminating the need for a second tow. This change will result in a savings, which allows for a change in the scope of work to include the removal of additional items recognized by the community with this current cleanup; without costing more money.

**RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATION:**
